Bus passes for older and disabled people: changes to rules

From 1 April, in England, the rules about free bus travel for people aged 60 or over and for disabled people are being changed. From that date, older and disabled people will no longer be entitled to free travel on certain services. These include intercity coaches, some park-and-ride buses, temporary rail replacement bus services and any services intended primarily for tourism. However, local authorities will be able to offer free travel on any of these excluded services on a discretionary basis. Clients should contact Sevenoaks District Council for further information.
