



Congestion charging NHS reimbursement scheme

Some people can get a refund of the London congestion charge when travelling to an NHS appointment. To be eligible, a patient must:

- have a compromised immune system, require regular therapy or assessment, or require recurrent surgical intervention; *and*
- be clinically assessed as too ill, weak or disabled to travel to an appointment on public transport.

The NHS organisation where the patient has an appointment will assess whether the patient is eligible for the reimbursement scheme. The £8 daily charge can then be claimed back from the relevant NHS organisation.
