## **Driving licence photographs**

Photocard driving licences need to be updated with a new photograph every ten years. The first cards were introduced in July 1998, so the DVLA will soon start reminding people about their need to renew their photocard. To renew your card, you must fill in form D1 which you can get at the post office. Then send the form to the DVLA with a new photograph and the fee of £17.50. You do not need to take your driving test again. If you do not renew your card on time, you could get fined.
